

13 Australian children removed from harm, 21 children identified internationally through the ACCCE Victim Identification Team

19 alleged offenders charged

Financial sextortion



In response to the increasing trend of sextortion of under 18 yearolds, the ACCCE and ThinkUKnow Program initiated an awarenessraising and education response across media, social media, schools, community groups, financial institutions and police stations

5,086 online blackmail and sexual extortion response kit downloads **10,405** sextortion posters sent to police stations **3,545** letters sent to high schools
